Storage	Store in cool and dark place
Cautions	Shake spray bottle well before use Do not spray products other than shoes and boots Do not spray to eyes and skins of people and animals Rinse with water immediately if get into eyes mistakenly Keep product away from reach of infants

The bad smell of foot is caused by the fatty acid called Isovaleric Acid.
This smell is not produced in the body of a person, but is produced by germs on the foot.
Such germs create Isovaleric Acid by decomposing the skins of feet in stuffy conditions.
